



Mega Slip & Slide Participant Disclaimer & Assumption of Risk

Please read carefully. By completing this form, you confirm you understand and accept the terms below.

Who Must Complete This Form

This disclaimer must be completed for every participant (slider).

- Participants aged 18 or over must complete and sign this form themselves.
- Participants under 18 must have this form completed and signed by their parent or legal guardian.
- If you are signing on behalf of a child, you confirm you are the parent or legal guardian and consent to their participation.
- Where one person books for a group, each participant must still have a completed disclaimer (or parent/guardian for under 18s).

Important Legal Notice

Nothing in this agreement excludes or limits liability for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of Borne Events Ltd, or for any liability that cannot be excluded or limited under the laws of England and Wales.

Acknowledgement of Risk

I understand that the Mega Slip & Slide is a physical, outdoor activity involving water, speed, moving surfaces and shared use by multiple participants. I accept that participation involves inherent risks, including (but not limited to):

- Slipping, falling, sprains, strains, bruising and impact injuries
- Collision with equipment, the inflatable, rings/bodyboards, or other participants
- Uneven ground, mud, ruts, stones, wet grass and slippery surfaces
- Weather-related risks including rain, wind and reduced visibility
- Risks associated with climbing steps/access scaffolding and moving around an outdoor site
- Risks arising from the behaviour or actions of other participants

I understand that accidents and injuries can occur despite reasonable safety measures and supervision.

I confirm that I am choosing to participate voluntarily and accept these risks.

Participant Requirements and Health Declaration

By signing this form I confirm that the participant:

- Is 4 years old or over
- Is confident in and around water
- Is in good personal fitness and good health
- Is not pregnant
- Is not under the influence of alcohol or drugs
- Is under 19 stone (121kg / 266lbs)
- Can climb the access steps/scaffolding and access the slide safely (or has their own personal assistance arranged)
- Does not have any condition that could be made worse by participation, including (but not limited to) serious back/neck issues, heart conditions, epilepsy, fainting/seizure disorders, or any condition affecting balance or mobility
- Has no broken bones, recent surgery, injuries, infections, open cuts/wounds, or contagious illness

I understand that Borne Events Ltd may refuse participation if staff believe it is unsafe for the participant to take part.

Under 18s and Supervision

- Participants aged 17 and under must always be supervised by a responsible adult while on site.
- If a child requires assistance within the activity area (including access steps/launch area), I understand that this support must be provided by their own parent/guardian/carer and may require the assisting adult to be booked as a participant if they need to access restricted areas.

SEND and Carer Support

SEND community members are welcome to book as usual. We understand some participants may need additional support. Our staff are here to help and support wherever we reasonably can, but they cannot provide 1:1 care or supervision. Anyone who requires dedicated support must attend with their own carer.

We also run dedicated SEND sessions with lower numbers and a calmer pace. Please see our social pages and booking portal for dates and details.

Carers are permitted. Please see our website for guidance on how to book/arrange a carer space in advance (we may be unable to add carers on the day if the session is full).

Safety Briefing and Following Instructions

I agree that the participant will:

- Arrive in time to attend a mandatory safety briefing (if you are late don't worry, we will still be able to brief you/your party)
- Follow all instructions given by staff immediately
- Use the slide, rings and bodyboards only as directed
- Slide in the correct position and follow safe spacing/queueing rules
- Exit the landing/run-out area promptly and safely as instructed

I understand that failing to follow instructions increases risk to the participant and others.

Respect Policy

Your safety and enjoyment matter to us. Our team is here to keep sessions fun, fair and running smoothly for everyone.

Everyone on site must follow staff instructions. In the Slip & Slide activity area, safety guidance must be followed immediately so we can prevent accidents and keep the session moving.

If anyone chooses to ignore instructions, behaves unsafely, or disrupts others, our staff will step in straight away. They will be removed from the activity area and will not be permitted to continue sliding. No refund will be issued.

Clothing, Jewellery and Personal Items

I understand that:

- Suitable swimwear/appropriate clothing must be worn
- Jewellery, watches and sharp objects must be removed before participating
- Pockets must be empty (phones, keys, vapes, etc.)
- The participant must follow any footwear rules given on the day
- Glasses must be firmly secured with a strap and are worn at the participant's own risk (and may restrict use of certain slide equipment as directed by staff)

Weather and Operational Safety

We operate in rain. However, we cannot operate in strong winds or if there is thunder and lightning overhead.

If weather changes suddenly, we may need to pause or close the slide at short notice for safety reasons. If we cancel a session, we will provide options to reschedule or request a refund in line with our published policy.

Parking & Exit

Parking is provided on grass farmland and vehicles are parked at the owner's risk. By entering and using the car park, you do so at your own risk. For traffic flow and safety when leaving the site, please follow signage and staff directions when exiting the car park, you must turn left only.

Personal Property

I understand that I am responsible for my personal belongings and that Borne Events Ltd cannot accept responsibility for loss, theft or damage to personal items.

Medical Treatment Consent

In the event of an accident or emergency, I consent to first aid being administered and to medical treatment being sought if required.

Photography & Video

I understand that photos and videos may be taken on site for safety, training and promotional purposes. If I do not wish to be photographed or filmed, I will inform staff on arrival.

Data Protection

Personal information provided will be used for booking, safety and insurance purposes in accordance with UK data protection law.

Limitation of Liability

To the fullest extent permitted by law, Borne Events Ltd will not be liable for any loss, damage or injury arising from participation where this is not caused by negligence.

Governing Law

This agreement is governed by the laws of England and Wales.

Severability

If any part of this agreement is found to be unenforceable, the remainder will continue in full force.
